1. Welcome Statement from President Jentry Eck
2. Approval of January General Assembly Meeting Minutes

6. General PTSA Activity Update by President Jentry Eck
  - a. Jentry Eck shared that the PTSA donated \$2500 dollars for the 6th Grade Washington DC scholarship fund.
  - b. Jenty shared that the high school principal (Mr. Kaiser) purchased individual tables for testing as well as for lunch from their \$2000 this year. They will be using the remainder of their funds for an end of year event for the HS that is still being planned by the school.
  - c. The president shared that the PTSA purchased books for Read Across America week as prizes for raffle drawings.
  - d. The president also shared an update regarding the Virtual Talent Show and the successful turnout from this event.
  - e. Jentry Eck shared that APEX would not happen this year due to financial struggles that Beechwood families may have experienced due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
  - f. Jentry shared with the assembly to look for advertising coming after spring break for the school supply fundraiser.
  - g. The president shared that the Great Create online auction that was going to happen this spring is going to be saved for the fall to be used as a part of SantaFest.
  - h. Jentry shared that the PTSA would be providing Kona Ice for "good faith effort" for KPREP testing for elementary (3-6th) and HS (7-8th, 10-11th) students.



- i. The president shared an update regarding the Student Supply Closet and the fact that the supplies are partially stocked and what is stocked can now be utilized.
  - j. Jentry briefly shared about the Perfect North member perk.
- 7. Spring Events Update
  - a. Mother-Daughter
